The program is designed to involve, teach, and motivate intermediate school youth; the "in- between" age group. Our runners have shared with us what **RunStrong** means to them. They talk about the value of being a part of a community, finding connections, building friendships, and doing better in school. **RunStrong** is an

County and because of the program's success, we are invited to join races throughout the area. The **RunStrong** Program continues to develop excellent runners who are winning awards. Twenty years after his untimely passing, Dr. Kevin Armstrong would be proud and flashing a huge smile to see the success of KAMSF in working with underserved youth in Santa Ana.
